- 1. Meeting called to order at 10:00 by Vice Chair Jacki Paone. Rick Hart volunteered to take minutes.
- 2. Introductions of new CIC members and DORA staff in attendance.
- 3. Welcome and introduction of one member of the public: Mark Wynne.
- 4. Open-meeting training was discussed for new members and reminders made to submit signed affidavits.
- 5. Keilani Fleming discussed extra protections for HOAs, seeking consumer input. Better replacement-cost estimating was suggested. Russ Meyer asked if this data could be monitored by DOI software. A stakeholder meeting was suggested. (JP Speers and Andrew Toig joined meeting)
- 4/9/2025 meeting minutes accepted subject to edits of attendees: motion Rick Hart, second JP Speers.
- 7. Old Business:
 - A. Common Interest/HOA Reserves for Insurance Deductibles. Discussion regarding increasing premiums, denials, importance of condos as starter homes. Future risks identified as: affordability, insurability, merchantability. (Bobbie Baca left meeting) Peg Ellefson moved to change numbering format to R-#-YY. Heidi seconded. Passed unanimously. Subject to changing condo language to "multi-unit," Peg Ellefson moved to accept the final version of R-19-25, JP Speers second. Passed unanimously.
 - B. No updates regarding HB 25-1182 re: transparency of insurance costs. Keep on agenda. Russ Myer mentioned HB 23-166 re: wildfire resiliency. Add to agenda for follow-up.

- 8. Public comment. Mark Wynne observed that the CIC had effectively advanced health insurance issues, was now focused on property insurance issues.
- 9. New Topics. Peg Ellefson raised the issue of Property & Casualty rate increases, that the CIC should remain vigilant.
